CCG 360° Stakeholder Survey

- 2.6 NHS England has again undertaken to conduct the CCG 360° stakeholder survey 2017 for the fifth year, on behalf of CCGs. As CCGs mature, the survey will assess whether their key relationships continue to be central to the effective commissioning of services by CCGs, and in doing so improve quality and outcomes for patients. As has been the case in previous years, the survey will serve two purposes:-
 - the statutory responsibility of NHS England to conduct an annual performance review of each CCG, assessing against the four domains of the 2016/17 CCG Improvement and Assessment Framework. The results from the survey will comprise part of this overall assessment. Data from a small number of survey measures will also feed directly into the effectiveness of working relationships in the local system indicator;
 - the survey results also provide a wealth of data. This data gives CCGs the
 opportunity to understand how stakeholder views have changed over time
 and to focus on key areas for improvement in relationships with
 stakeholders.
- 2.7 The survey will take place from 16 January 2017 to 24 February 2017 with the results being available after 31 March 2017.
