#### 1. Introduction

- 1.1. The Governing Body previously approved amendments to the Remuneration Committee Terms of Reference to enable it to deal with matters specifically delegated to it by the Governing Body.
- 1.2. Recent guidance suggests that remuneration committees for NHS employers should consider (and in the case of NHS Dorset CCG make recommendations to the Governing Body) severance payments for all staff.

#### 2. Report

- 2.1. The current Terms of Reference restrict the Remuneration Committee to considering severance payments for senior officers within the CCG. In order to meet the recently issued guidance, amendments are needed to widen the scope of the role of the Remuneration Committee.
- 2.2. Appendix A contains the current Terms of Reference with tracked changes highlighting the minor amendments required to enable the Remuneration Committee to consider severance packages for all staff.

#### 3. Conclusion

3.1. The Governing Body is asked to approve the changes required to enable the Remuneration Committee to consider severance payments for all staff in the CCG with immediate effect.
