		Financial Viability; tariff, other payment arrangements, contracting, efficiency savings				The contractual discussions have been incredibly challenging for 2016/17 and have required escalation to Accountable Officers for 2 of our providers. The deadline for determining whether providers and CCGs would go to arbitration was the 25th April and we have an agreed position between ourselves and each of the providers and do not require arbitration to conclude the contract setting. The financial envelopes are all agreed.  We do however still have a requirement to deliver the 1% Headroom of £11m and with the contract settlements made during negotiations the current position adjusted for a full contingency release requires delivery of a QIPP of at least £11.5m.  In addition there are a number of risks to the financial position, such as over-performance at RBH capped at £4m, over-performance at DCH capped at £1m and challenges on over-performance in both the Non-NHS and smaller providers, as well as holding a flat cash CHC position. The over-performance in the provider areas is likely at least in part if we do not deliver mitigating actions through QIPP such as demand management.  We are still pursuing access to the STP Funding that has not arrived in Dorset via NHS Improvement as part of a system control total with the CCG and Acute's, however it is too early to determine the success or not of this.  A QIPP task-force is in the process of being set up and names have been put forward, this will be led by the Accountable Officer with support from the Chief Finance Officer and supported by the named individuals agreed.	÷

It also marked the beginning of the more important and exciting process for the CCG of understanding how those vanguard proposals might support the vision for Integrated Community Services (ICS) across Dorset. Following submission of all plans a small technical group was convened, on 22 April 2016, to consider and evaluate the submitted plans against the criteria as described in the original ICS Vanguard application process. All six ICS Vanguard Plans were found to be compliant with the project requirements, as described in the original application process, and with the conditions contained within their specific ICS Vanguard contract. The challenge now is to determine how the ICS Vanguard proposals can best support and inform the emerging design emanating from the ICS Programme, and possible a locality level view, so that a joined up and comprehensive design for ICS can be presented to the CCG Governing Body in July 2016. A series of vanguard presentations have been arranged to take place at CWG10 on 4 May 2016. All plans will be made available to relevant colleagues across the health and social care system with plans also being shared across the vanguard groups. An assessment of vanguard plans will be undertaken in the coming weeks to establish the extent to which the proposals could support the vision for ICS.	↔
