## 1. Introduction

- 1.1 The CCGs Constitution and/or Statute requires that one or more registers of the interests of members of the CCG, members of its Governing Body, members of its committees, GPs remunerated by the Governing Body and CCG employees are maintained and published on the Group's website and reviewed by the Governing Body.
- 1.2 This requirement is supplemented by the CCGs values, particularly to work honestly and openly and to be transparent.

## 2. Report

- 2.1 All members of the Governing Body, its committees, GPs remunerated by the Governing Body, staff and member practices have all been asked to declare interests which they have which do or may conflict with the interests of the CCG.
- 2.2 All members of staff, most member practices and all Governing Body and committee members have responded declaring that they either have no interests or declaring the interests that they have that may conflict with those of the CCG.
- 2.3 At the time of writing this report, 26 February 2014, there were 61 remunerated GPs and 17 member practices who had neither confirmed that they had no conflicting interests or declared conflicting interests. These individuals and practices are being actively pursued to achieve compliance.
