- 2.5 The Court confirmed that the CCG had taken into account all the matters that it was required to consider during the Clinical Services Review and consultation processes.

- 2.6 I hope that this will reassure local people and councillors that the CCG has acted properly and in the interests of health and care services in Dorset.
- 2.7 Whilst a claim for Judicial Review is a process available, it has involved considerable cost to the NHS.
- 2.8 The decision will now allow us to further implement the planned improvements to health and care services in Dorset.
