1. Introduction

- 1.1 The framework provides assurance to the Governing Body of the controls that are in place to mitigate the key risks that could impact on the CCG's delivery of its strategic objectives.
- 1.2 This report provides the current version (Appendix 1) of the Governing Body Assurance Framework (GBAF) for information.
- 1.3 The framework is linked to the Strategic Objectives of the organisation and also serves as a source of external assurance for the NHS England – South West quarterly assurance processes.
- 1.4 The Directors' Performance meeting has operational responsibility for maintaining the Governing Body Assurance Framework (GBAF) with support from the Patient Safety and Risk team.

2. Internal Audit

- 2.1 The final version 2017/18 Assurance Review of Assurance Framework and Risk Management was received on 27 March 2018. The overall assurance assessment was 'reasonable assurance'.
- 2.2 Seven recommendations were made, all relating to the Governing Body Assurance Framework, with actions to be completed for all seven actions by 31 December 2018.
- 2.3 One action, with a deadline of 31 December 2018, has yet to be started. Action 2 detailed for the strategic risks to be graded as 'very high', 'high', 'medium' or 'low' risk by the Directors. This action will be carried out for Q3 2018-19 in early January and will be closed once the first quarterly assessment has been completed. It is anticipated that this action will be closed by 31.01.2019. All actions will then be completed.
- 2.4 Updates relating to the progress against actions is reported quarterly to the Audit and Quality Committee.

3. Gaps in Controls and Assurances

- 3.1 No gaps in assurance are currently identified in the Assurance Framework as at 19 December 2018 and no gaps have been identified since the previous report.
- 3.2 Additional control requirements and gaps in the control requirements will be identified during the implementation of the internal audit recommendations.

4. Recommendation

- 4.1 The Governing Body is asked to **note** the Assurance Framework format and contents.
