Response:

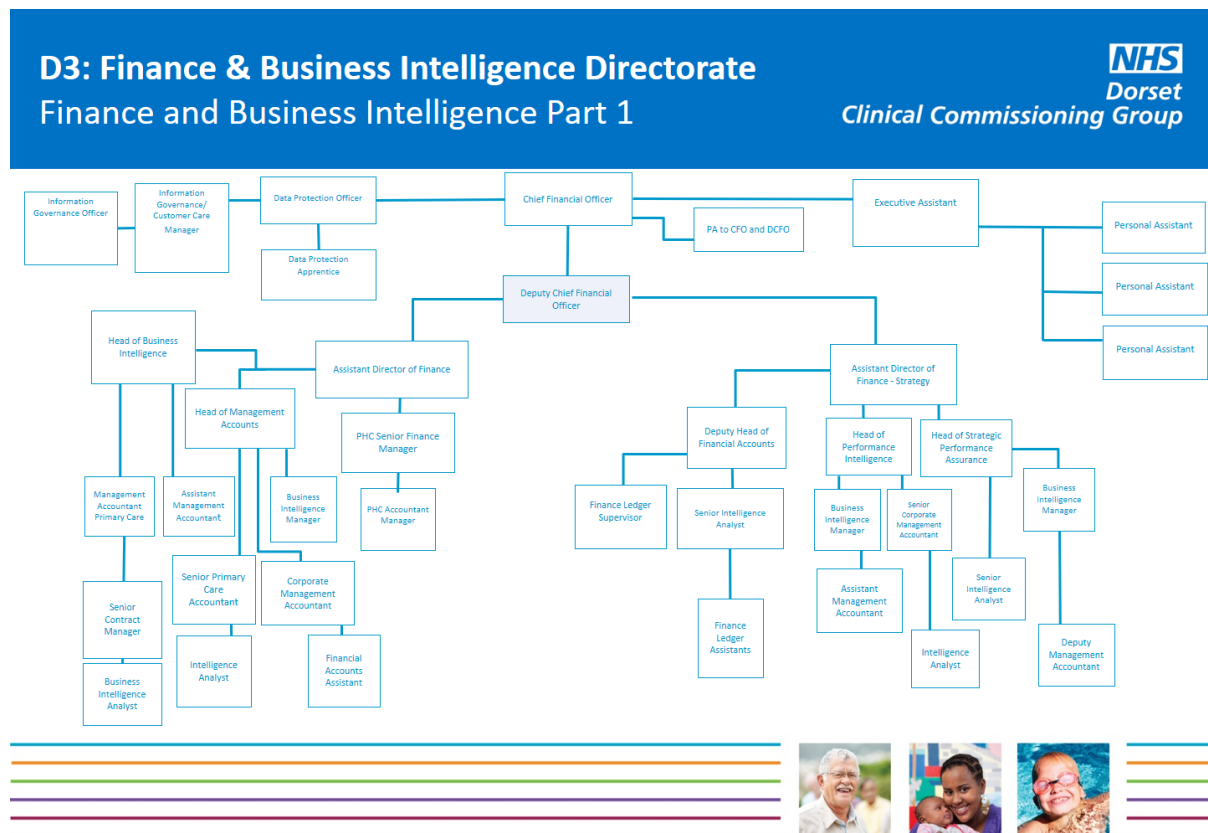
Yes, NHS Dorset CCG does have an in-house business intelligence team.

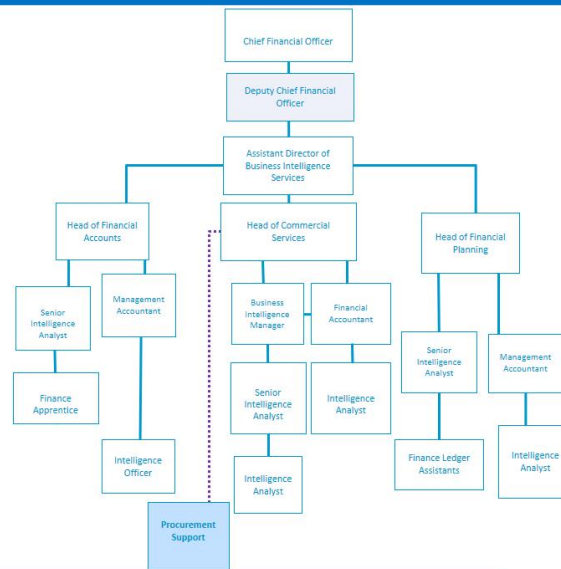
Q2:
