Covid-19 Update**Phase 3 of NHS response to COVID-19 - Recovery planning**

- 2.1 The final Phase 3 Recovery Plan for the system was submitted to NHS England and Improvement on 22 October 2020, setting out how the system plans to recover health and care services, whilst managing the additional demands of winter pressures, and living alongside Covid-19 and responding to the second spike.

- 2.2 Although as a system progress has been made in the recovery of services, our plan highlights the challenges faced in being able to fully recover all services within the current pressures being seen - rising Covid-19 and the infection, protection and control guidance impacting on the capacity available and workforce pressures.
- 2.3 Processes are in place to monitor progress and to identify any risks to recovery.
